The Commission will review all applications/resumes submitted and act as a Nominating Committee as prescribed in our enabling legislation. The applications of those nominated by the Commission will be mailed to the registered voters in the District for consideration. A formal polling will then occur on Tuesday, July 16, 2019 at Christ Lutheran Church, the usual polling place for District 7A. Since we can only recommend our choice to the Delegation, this is a "non-binding" vote. Although the delegation is under no obligation to accept our recommendation, they have done so in the past.
